We will be building a new pedestrian crossing in your neighbourhood soon and would like to share some important information.


# What are we doing?

- Construction of a raised pedestrian zebra crossing.
- Storm water pit modification works.
- Construction of concrete kerb outstands.
- Construction of tree squares within the kerb outstands.
- Rearrange on-street disabled parking bays with a new access ramp.
- Associated road pavement and footpath reinstatement works.
- Line-marking works as required.
- Tree planting works will take place after the completion of civil works.

# Where are the works happening?

The works are happening on Gleadell Street, between Bridge Road and Highett Street in Richmond.

#### When will the work start?

The works are scheduled to commence on **Monday 24 September 2018** and are expected to take 2-3 weeks to complete, subject to weather conditions.

Working hours - 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday.

There may be some noise and dust during the works, but we will try to keep this to a minimum.

# Who will be carrying out the works?

Works will be carried out by Council contractor Bosco Civil P/L. Please contact Claud Bosco on 0411 100 817.

## Will I be able to access the street?

An appropriate traffic management plan will be in place to ensure that traffic can flow through Gleadell Street during working hours. However, there will be a total road closure in place towards the end of the project with diversions for drivers and cyclists.

Traffic controllers will be in place to guide local traffic when required. Normal traffic access will resume after 5:00pm every weekday. There will be no road work activities on weekend.

The Gleadell Street Market will continue to operate on Saturdays.

There will be some impact on pedestrians during footpath reinstatement works. However, pedestrian access to Richmond Recreation Centre, Richmond Multicultural Children's Centre and Richmond High School will be maintained throughout.

Please consult with our contractor if you require assistance with access.

### Where do I park my car?

Street parking will not be available during working hours along the section of the street under reconstruction and appropriate signs will be displayed.

Some on-street parking spaces will be used for the storage of materials and equipment. These areas will be properly barricaded and progressively emptied as works move along.

At the end of each working week the works site will be cleared and only those areas which are under construction will remain barricaded.

Works will be carried out in sections to minimise inconvenience. This restriction will allow the works to be completed quickly.
